

## 2007-2008 Employment Survey Employer Questions

To get a more accurate picture of employment trends in the field, the EIS Center created a web-based, anonymous survey to track hirings by specialization and to collect demographic information on job candidates. In the spring of 2008, surveys were sent to all employers who advertised a position in *Openings* in 2007. Of the 543 solicitations, 148 responses were received (27.25% response rate). Below are complete results. The survey is performed online, and the horizontal lines below represent a new page of questions.

1) How many complete applications did you receive for this position? (responses vary from 1 to 955, average of 72)
