Curriculum Vitae

All candidates have the option of filing a Curriculum Vitae (CV) with the EIS Center. Candidates who preregister may upload the CV to the EIS Web site. The CV upload system will be ready on July 15 and all registered candidates will receive an e-mail with upload instructions. Onsite registrants, and those who do not upload the CV by the deadline, may bring two copies to the EIS Center at the Annual Meetings to be filed alphabetically.
